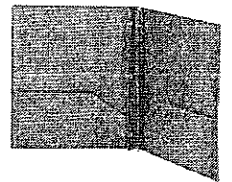
First Grade School Supply List

- A 1 inch 3 ring binder (any color)



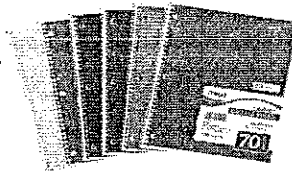
- 2 boxes of pencils with erasers (Dixon or Ticonderoga)

- One- 2 pocket plastic durable folder with fasteners



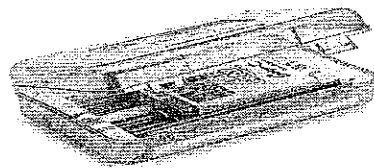
- One- 2 pocket plastic durable folder without fasteners

You may review these words in several ways:

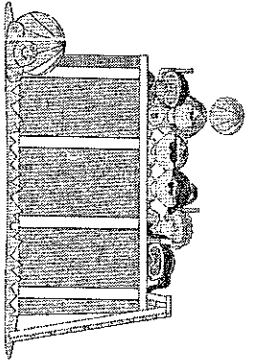
- *Write the words on index cards and use them as flash cards
