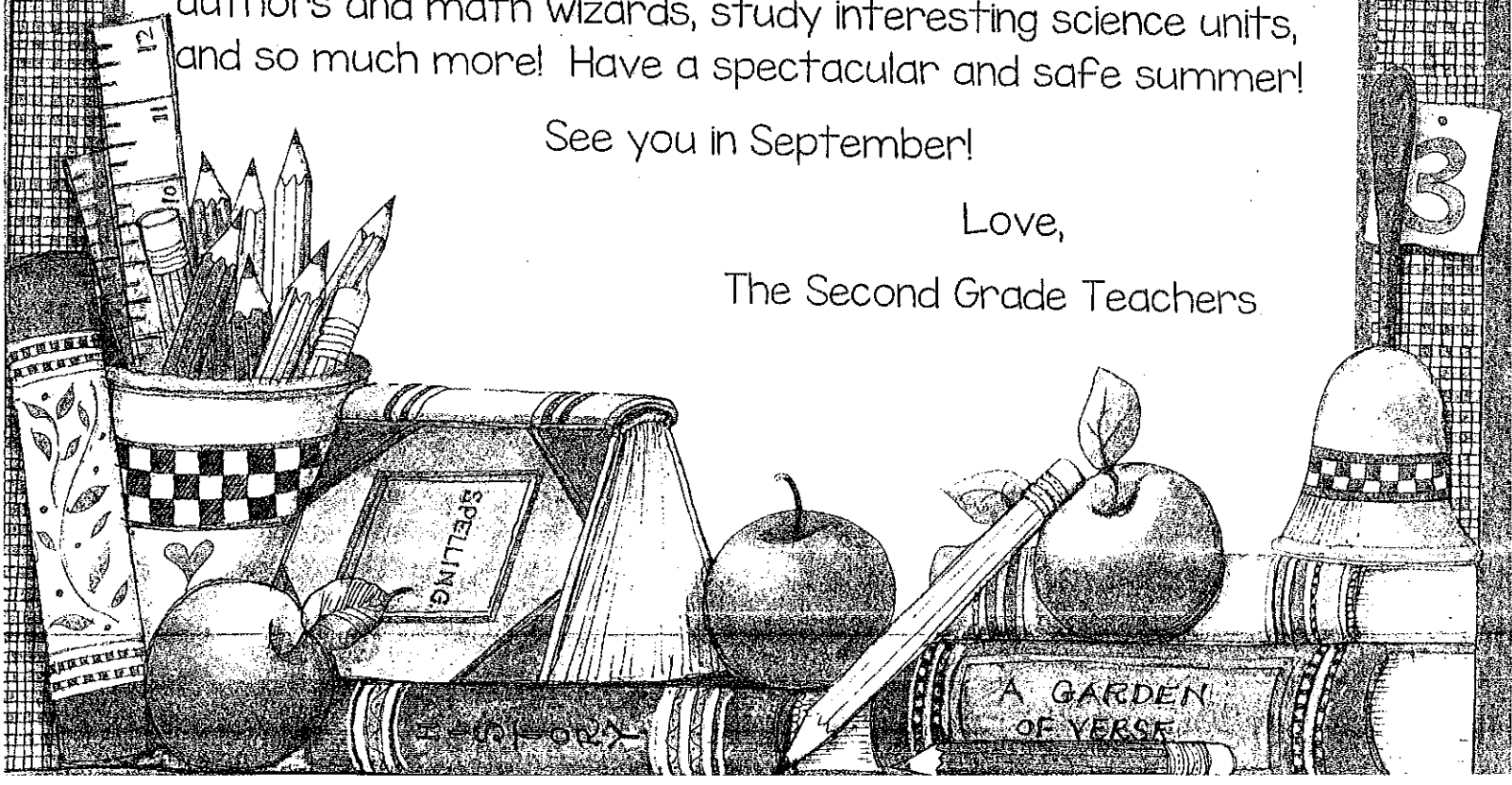
A "supply wish list" is included as well. Please be sure to label your child's belongings with his or her name and bring everything with you on our first day as well. Thanks!
